Are you in compliance with DOT hazmat requirements?

The 2019 NH₃ Safety Training has been designed to meet the requirements under DOT Title 49, CFR 172.704, Hazmat Training for NH₃.

Who should attend?

Hazmat employee means a person who is employed by a hazmat employer and directly affects hazmat transportation safety including an owner-operator of a motor vehicle which transports hazmat; a person (including a self-employed person) who:

- Is a driver of a Hazmat loaded vehicle (includes towing)
- Loads a vehicle for transportation with Hazmat material
- Repairs a vehicle used for transporting Hazmat material (to include on-road repairs)
- Oversees the transportation of Hazmat load
- Prepares the paperwork required in completing the load of Hazmat materials, and most importantly, is the manager of the facility overseeing any of the above listed personnel and who directly affects the hazardous materials transportation safely.

Why Attend? Training Requirements

Each hazmat employer must: train and test, certify and develop, and retain records of current training (inclusive of preceding three years) for hazmat employee (during the period of employment and 90 days thereafter).
