Custom Applicator School Information
Tuesday, February 24 &
Wednesday, February 25, 2026

Purpose: This workshop has been especially designed to instruct custom applicators in the specifics needed in their field of technology. The custom applicator training is intensive and detailed. It will take applicators through professional compliance, liquid calibration & calculations, dry fertilizer calibration, markers, tank cleaning, compatibility & mixing orders, and doing a professional job.

Who Should Attend: Employees, especially newly hired, who will be doing your fertilizer and ag-chemical applications whether with floaters, spray rigs, coups or pull-type applicators, both liquid and dry.

What You Get: The two-day Custom Applicator Training includes a course manual, coffee and rolls each morning, morning and afternoon refreshment breaks, lunch, a pocket calculator to keep, and a certificate of attendance.

A special Work/Study Exam Review will be offered Tuesday and Wednesday evening at Central Community College, immediately following the training day. Attendance is optional but Highly Recommended.

Commercial Pesticide Applicator Initial Testing and Re-Certification General Information
Thursday, February 26, 2026

Purpose: To review information necessary to successfully pass the State of Nebraska Commercial Pesticide Applicator License exams. Initial testing will be given on Thursday, February 26, 2026. **This day is optional and only for those who need to initial test or re-certify their Commercial Pesticide Applicator license.** Two hours of review are provided prior to each exam. The first exam is the General Standards (00) Exam and the second is the Ag Plant Category Exam (01). All of the questions on the exams are based upon the information in the study packets.

Study Materials: Study Materials for the Commercial Pesticide Applicator General Standards and Ag Plant exams are **highly recommended**, and are available from the University of Nebraska. Remember you need to order "General Standards" (Category Number 00) and "Agricultural Pest Control - Plant" (Category Number 01). **Study material can be purchased at <http://pested.unl.edu>. NO phone orders are accepted.**

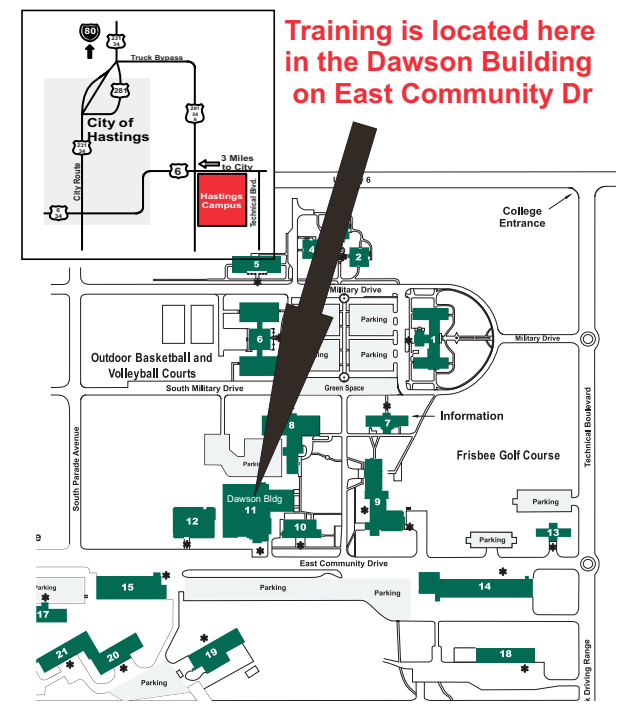
